#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-03**

The Village of Grand Beach Council resolves:

SECTION 1: **Title**—This resolution shall be known as the Village of Grand Beach 2023 General Appropriations Act.

SECTION 2: **Public Hearing on the Budget-Pursuant to MCLA 141.412 and .413**, notice of a public hearing on the proposed budget was published in a newspaper of general circulation on April 7, 2022 and a special meeting on the proposed budget and millage associated with the budget was held on May 18, 2022.

SECTION 3: Millage Levy—The Village of Grand Beach Council shall cause to be levied and collected the general property tax on all real and personal property within the Village upon the current tax roll an allocated millage of <u>5.9196</u> Mills for general operations.

SECTION 4: Adoption of budget by Activity/Department—Village of Grand Beach Council adopts the 2022-2023 fiscal year budgets for the various funds by Activity/Department. Village officials responsible for the expenditures authorized in the budget may expend Village funds up to, but not to exceed, the total appropriation authorized for each Activity/Department.

SECTION 5: Payment of Bills—Pursuant to MCLA 41.75, all claims (bills) against the Village shall be approved by the Village of Grand Beach Council prior to being paid. The Village Clerk may pay certain bills prior to approval by the Village Council to avoid late penalties, service charges and interest (primarily utilities) and payroll in accordance with the approved salaries and hourly rates adopted by the council. The Council President shall have the authority to approve any bills that must be paid during any declared federal, state or local state of emergency, severe weather emergency or when it is impractical or impossible to meet as a result of any government action. The Village Council shall receive a list of claims (bills) paid prior to approval for approval at the next Council meeting.

SECTION 6: Estimated Revenues and Expenditures—Estimated total revenues and expenditures for the various funds of the Village of Grand Beach are:
